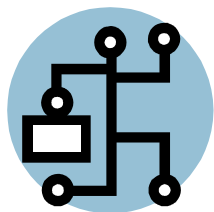

Registration will be from 9:15—9:30 at each location. The program will run from 9:30 until 12:30, with one snack break. Participants will be on their own for lunch.

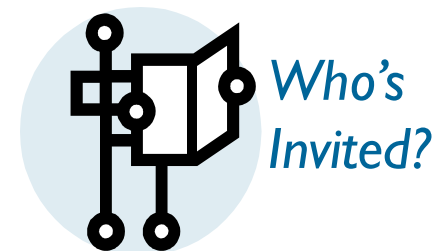
